Program faculty at educator preparation programs (EPPs) participating in edTPA are encouraged to review the candidate policies and the [edTPA Guidelines and Policies for Faculty](#) posted on [edTPA.com](https://edtpa.com).

Program faculty affiliated with educator preparation programs participating in edTPA may create an [edTPA member profile](#) to receive full access the edTPA resources materials available on [edTPA.AACTE.org](https://edtpa.aacte.org). Once the profile is approved, faculty may review and download edTPA handbooks from the edTPA Resource Library.

Register for edTPA

Candidates planning to submit their portfolios to Pearson for official scoring must register at [edTPA.com](https://edtpa.com). Prior to registration, they should follow these key steps:

- Review state-specific edTPA requirements, approved handbooks, and passing scores at the “Candidates” page.
- Review the edTPA Registration Overview document describing the registration process.
- When ready, candidates will follow these instructions to register for edTPA.
- Review edTPA submission and reporting dates to plan the edTPA submission based on when results are needed. Faculty should advise candidates of any program specific deadlines to meet program requirements.

Access to Handbooks and Resources

Candidates may receive access to handbooks, templates, and supplemental resources in the following ways:

- 1.) Access to edTPA handbooks, templates, supplemental resources, and materials for program faculty can be found at [edTPA.AACTE.org](https://edtpa.aacte.org) within the [edTPA Resource Library](#) and [Online Community](#). Faculty may download and distribute to candidates via password protected campus platforms, email or hard copy. Please note handbooks are not to be posted on public areas of campus websites.
- 2.) Upon registration, candidates will receive access to the Pearson ePortfolio Platform, where they can build and submit their portfolio online. Within the platform, candidates may download the handbook, templates, and key resources for the registered assessment in the field they plan to earn a teaching license.
- 3.) Candidates may access handbooks through an integrated edTPA Platform Provider system, if programs plan to use this system for candidates to build their portfolios on your campus’ integrated edTPA Platform Provider system.

Candidates should read through the edTPA handbook in the assessment area in which they have registered. They are also encouraged to review the supplemental resources providing additional guidance as they plan, prepare, and assess students.

Using the Pearson ePortfolio System

For educator preparation programs using the faculty feedback feature of the Pearson ePortfolio system, candidates will have the ability to request feedback from program faculty prior to submission. Guidance documents such as the [Using the Pearson ePortfolio System](#) and online video tutorials are available for faculty reviewers. For administrators, the [Using the Manage Institution Users Tool](#) resource provides information on maintaining the list of assigned faculty reviewers at your institution.

Requesting an Alternative to Video Evidence

Teacher candidates may encounter situations that inhibit the ability to submit edTPA materials that meet the technical specifications for artifacts as outlined within the [edTPA Submission Requirements](#). For example, there are settings where recording a video is prohibited because of safety and security concerns. Only candidates who have completed and confirmed a *Request to Submit Alternative Evidence* form may submit alternative forms of evidence. edTPA Coordinators may request the form by contacting edTPA EPP Support at edTPAEPPSupport@pearson.com. edTPA Score Reporting

The person designated as the primary score reporting contact during the edTPA EPP onboarding process will be able to extend to other users in your organization the ability to set up accounts and access score reporting data.

edTPA Score results are made available to EPPs and state agencies through the EdReports score reporting portal - a secure, password-protected web-based data site. Institution Reports (data files) will be available per the [submission and reporting schedule](#).

ResultsAnalyzer® is a web-based, interactive reporting tool available within your program's edReports account. ResultsAnalyzer® allows the user to view, analyze, reorganize, download, print, and export registration and assessment results data.

Purchasing Vouchers

Programs may purchase edTPA program fee vouchers in several denominations for distribution to candidates who may use them in lieu of payment. Be sure to order vouchers in advance of their intended use.

To order vouchers:

1. Complete a Voucher Request Form, indicating the number of vouchers you wish to purchase and the individual voucher dollar amount requested. Please read the Voucher Request Form carefully, especially the expiration and refund policies.
2. Attach a check or purchase order payable to Evaluation Systems for the total cost to the form.
3. Submit your completed voucher request form and payment.

About edTPA Vouchers

Please remember that:

- Vouchers will be sent via a standard Excel spreadsheet, within 2 weeks after receipt of completed Voucher Request Form and purchase order or check.
- Vouchers will be valid for a period of 18 months from the date they are generated.
- Vouchers cannot be applied retroactively to existing registrations. A candidate must enter a voucher code in the system as payment during the registration process.

Vouchers that have expired unused will be replaced by Pearson upon request as a one-time courtesy and sent to the Institution after the original voucher expiration date. Therefore, no refund or credit is available to the Institution for expired vouchers. Vouchers are single use vouchers, valid for one registration up to the maximum voucher amount.
